Environment Initiative

Recently the Ghasri Local Council held meetings with Green mt to discuss how our locality can increase the collection of recycled waste. Last year our village took second place in Gozo as the locality which collected the most recycled waste in the 'grey-bag scheme', done every Tuesday. We would therefore like to thank all those who participate in this initiative. **Those who would like to participate in this scheme can call at our office and collect grey bags free of charge.**

The Council is looking forward to increase the collection of recycled waste. A new scheme is to be introduced with the co-operation of Green mt. L-Ghasri will be the first locality in Gozo to start collecting glass from door to door. Green mt has already provided plastic containers which are to be distributed free of charge to residents who are interested in participating in this scheme. **Therefore if you are interested you can call at our office and collect your plastic container.** The collection of glass will be every Thursday morning. Once the contractor has collected the glass, he will then leave the container on your doorstep to re-use the next week. **The glass collection scheme will be introduced as from Thursday 5th April, 2012.**

We would like to inform you that as from April 2012 domestic waste will not be collected on Thursdays. The Council appreciates your co-operation to make this initiative a success. This is a pilot-project which is being kicked-off by our locality, and is to later be introduced in other localities. We would like to emphasize that the tipping fees that the Council pays for such domestic waste collection may be reduced by this scheme and this would therefore mean having more money left-over to plan and carry out other beneficial projects to our locality.

On one last note, the L-Ghasri Local Council and the Green mt would like to thank you for your collaboration and enthusiasm in favour of a greener and healthier environment.
