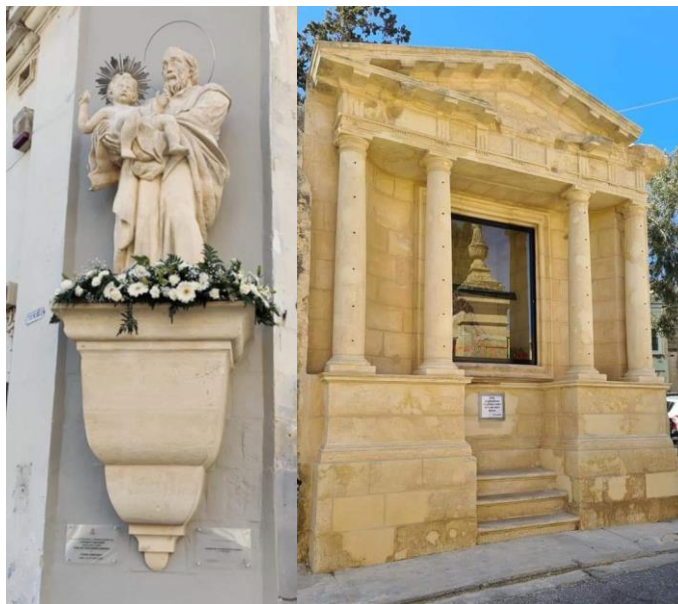




Kunsill Lokali Ħaż-Żabbar
Città Hompesch

Bi pjaċir nixtiequ ninfurmaw lill-pubbliku li l-Kunsill Lokali ta' Ħaż-Żabbar għamel xogħol ta' restawr fuq l-istatwa ta' San Ġużepp fi Triq is-Santwarju u n-niċċa ta' Ġesù Redentur fi Triq iċ-Ċimiterju, permezz tal-Miżura 1 – Nivvalorizzaw il-Wirt Kulturali f'Ċittà Hompesch. Dan ir-restawr isahhaħ l-importanza tal-harsien tal-patrimonju kulturali tagħna li għandu jgawdih kulhadd u jigi ppreservat għall-generazzjonijiet futuri. Dawn l-istatwi u niċċ reliġjużi jagħtu karattru lill-irhula tagħna u juruna kif patrimonju reliġjuż bħal dan iħalli marka fuq it-tradizzjonijiet Maltin, l-arkitettura, id-drawwiet u l-ħajja fl-irhula. Barra minn hekk, restawr bħal dan jattratta iktar vizitaturi, kemm lokali u kemm barranin, lejn l-irhula tagħna u jtejjeb il-kwalità tal-ħajja tar-residenti tal-lokalità u tax-Xlokk iġenerali. Dan il-proġett ġie ko-finanzjat mill-Unjoni Ewropeja taħt il-Fond Agrikolu Ewropew għall-Iżvilupp Rurali (2014-2020).

We would like to inform the general public that, the Ħaż-Żabbar Local Council has restored the statue of St Joseph in Sanctuary Street and the niche of Jesus the Redeemer in Cemetery Street, through Measure 1 – Valorising Cultural Assets in Città Hompesch, highlighting the importance of the preservation of our common cultural heritage, which benefits all and, also preserves it for future generations. Such religious statues and niches lend character to our villages and evidence how religious heritage has permeated Maltese traditions, customs and architecture. This restoration makes our villages more attractive to visitors, both locals and tourists, and overall, it improves the quality of life of the residents of our locality and that of Xlokk residents as a whole.
